The Spice Box is located in the lobby of the hospital and is staffed by volunteers. All proceeds benefit Noyes Health.

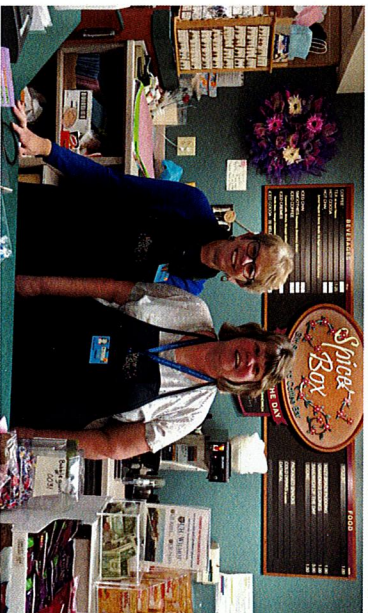
Scholarship Committee

A History of Financial Support for the Hospital

In 1969, the Auxiliary pledged \$15,000 over five years for the construction of the Nicholas H. Noyes Memorial Hospital. Fundraising efforts started with that pledge and continue today.

Fundraising Sales

The Auxiliary periodically sponsors sales such as book and jewelry sales and a Craft Boutique. Items are offered at discount prices and are very popular.
