Thank you for inquiring about postgraduate training in the Temporomandibular Joint Dysfunction Program in the University of Rochester Eastman Department of Dentistry. The one- to three-year TMJD Program is under the direction of Dr. Ross Tallents. There is no stipend and no tuition for this program.

Opportunities are also available to participate in graduate programs leading to the MS, MPH, MBA, or PhD degree in the University of Rochester. Your acceptance into the training program does not guarantee acceptance into a degree-granting program as each of these programs has unique requirements for acceptance.

The enclosed package also contains forms for your three letters of recommendation and an application. You should give the forms to the dean's office at your dental school and to two senior faculty members, or other appropriate people. Please ask them to mail the completed letters of recommendation directly to the Eastman Department of Dentistry. Your college and dental school transcripts should also be forwarded. Board scores should be sent directly to us from the ADA.

Once all required letters of recommendation, transcripts, and your completed application with a \$125.00 application fee are received, your file will be forwarded to the TMJD Program for review and selection for interviews. That process will begin on October 15th of the year before the start of the program.
