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Journals, Books, and Databases

You will find **extensive collections** covering all aspects of medicine and nursing at Miner Library. We provide access to nearly 300 health-related e-books and over 25,000 electronic journals. The print collections include more than 240,000 volumes of journals, books, and theses. Print and electronic books, journals, and theses are cataloged in Voyager, the University of Rochester's online catalog.

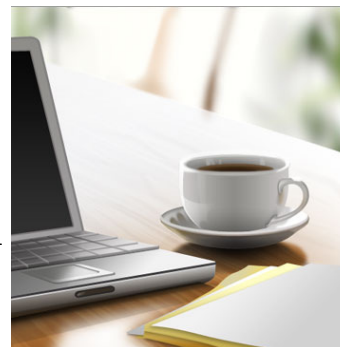

Computing

Both PCs and Macs are available; both desktops and laptops. While many desktop stations are open to all customers on a drop-in basis, the Computing Center (CC) is available to UR affiliates only. All workstations permit access to Miner's e-resources, the Web, and printing in color or black & white. Document scanning and editing is available in the CC.

Don't want to be tied down to a desktop? Take advantage of our **laptop lending program**. Check out a laptop or an iPad from the Answer Desk using your UR ID.

Trained consultants staff the CC Help Desk during regular business hours to assist



you with: **software**, including Microsoft Office, graphics and statistical programs, and a range of instructional software geared toward students; setting up and accessing **Blackboard** and your **student email** account; getting **access to Miner's e-resources from off campus**; configuring your **laptop** (or other mobile device) to take advantage of **wireless networking**. Miner also provides support for many additional workstations in the medical and graduate student computing labs and other medical education facilities.

Multimedia and Study Areas

Miner's historic main reading room is a good place for **quiet reading, relaxing, or studying**. Housed in this area are print journals, and the display area for recently received journals and new books. Study carrels are located on all three levels. **Group study** rooms on the first- and second-level stacks are for use by individuals or small groups for any length of time during library hours on a first-come, first-served basis.

If you have a URMIC ID, you may use the **multimedia room** in the Computing Center for up to three hours. It's equipped with a Macintosh multimedia computer with video/audio editing software, VCR, DVD player, network connection, and marker board (markers provided on request), and has space for two to five people.

Borrowing

With your ID card, you can borrow:

- Books and Theses - 14 days
- DVDs and VHS tapes - 1 day
- Software - 14 days
- Laptop or iPad - 6 hours

Please note: Effective 9/6/11, bound journals do not circulate.

Renew materials in person, by phone, or in Voyager <http://miner.lib.rochester.edu>. If an item you need is checked out, place a hold on it and

we will notify you when it's available.

Fines:

- Books - 20¢/day
- Reserve items - 75¢/hour
- Recalled items - \$1/day
- Laptop or iPad - \$5/hour

Interlibrary Loan

Need an article or book that Miner doesn't own? Just place your request using ILLiad, our electronic document delivery service at <https://illiad.lib.rochester.edu/MIN>. (You'll need to register in ILLiad first, before placing requests.) **Order documents** electronically while you're doing a database search in PUBMED®, MEDLINE®, CINAHL, PsycINFO, etc. Most requests are filled in 2-4 days. Indicate on the ILLiad request

form if you need something in a hurry.

Cost per item is \$5 for faculty/staff, \$3 for residents, and \$2 for students. Pay for ILL materials with a grant/account number, or you can be billed. Articles are delivered electronically to your ILLiad account; books are available for pick-up at the Answer Desk.

Photocopying

Both **color** and **black & white** photocopiers are available for self-service photocopying. But if you're in a hurry, we'll copy articles from Miner's collection. Generally, articles are available within 24 hours for \$5/item. Place requests using ILLiad (don't forget to register in the system first!) at <https://illiad.lib.rochester.edu/MIN>.

Articles are delivered electronically to your

ILLiad account. Payment options include grant/account number or you can be billed. Full service photocopying is available only for materials Miner owns and is subject to copyright laws.

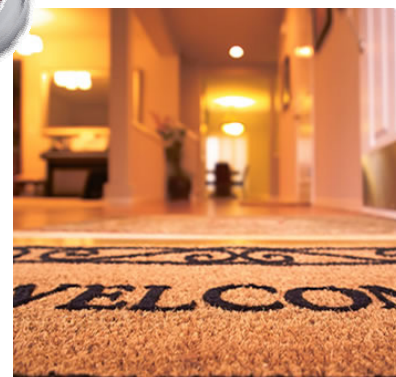
We're experts in locating the information you need—print or electronic. We also offer many other services, including help with: **Orientation tours** for individuals or groups, tailored to meet your specific information needs; **navigating e-resources** from your desktop or handheld; and **creating current awareness profiles** for those who require the most up-to-date, ongoing research on a topic.

We can carry out **customized literature searches** in a variety of databases, including MEDLINE®, to retrieve a list of journal articles on a subject or by a particular author. You may prefer to have a librarian do a customized search for you if the topic is complex or if you need a

comprehensive search to comply with federal guidelines involving human or animal subjects. Your customized search can be completed within 1-2 working days, and there is no fee for this service.

Our **Liaison Program** partners each URM department with a librarian, who becomes familiar with your department and its unique information needs.

e-Learning Resources

Need citation management resources? In collaboration with River Campus Libraries and Information Technology Services, Miner provides access to both **RefWorks** and **EndNote** at no additional cost to faculty, staff, and students.

Library Classes

We offer a variety of classes on a regular schedule and also by special request. Library classes are open to faculty, staff, and students at no cost and most are hands-on. Complete class descriptions are available on our website. Any of our classes can be customized to meet the special needs of your classroom, department, or URM group and can be scheduled by request.

classrooms. Class topics range from learning “library survival skills” and search strategies for our numerous biomedical and genomic databases, to using specific resources (Blackboard, Reference Manager, etc.).

Rare Books and Manuscripts

Rare Books and Manuscripts provides access to 25,000 rare books, more than 800 rare serial titles, 1,500 linear feet of archival and manuscript material, and a supporting collection of 5,000 circulating books and journals on the history of medicine. Miner has outstanding collections in pre-1800 anatomy, dentistry, obstetrics and gynecology, orthopedics, yellow fever, cholera, and American popular medicine. Services

include: **Access** to rare book and archival collections; **bibliographic assistance** in locating primary and secondary materials; **medical historical reference** services.
