Adaptive Release Rules

Overview

Add adaptive release rules to the item that you would like to conditionally show based on certain criteria. For example, if you would like to show a test only after a document has been reviewed, then add a rule to the test (not the document). Other examples are “test not passed” message or a certificate of completion. In this case you would add the rule to the message or certificate (not the test).

Steps

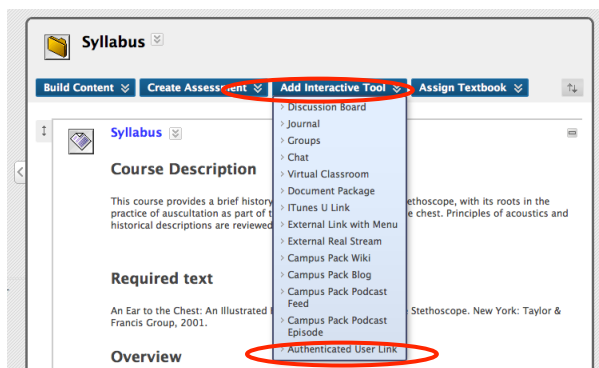
1. Click the Course Information Item Options button () located next to the title of the item you want the adaptive release to be associated with.
2. Click on Adaptive Release
3. Select criteria
4. Submit
5. To double check your own rules click on “Advanced Adaptive Release”, which will display any rules that you have set in clear English.
6. Please test all of your rules. Rules based on “reviewable” items can be checked while you are logged in as an instructor. For rules based on test scores, please log in as a test student because instructor grades are not saved to the grade center (or to HRMS).

Certificates

You might already have a certificate from a previous course that you would like to modify to suit your new course needs.

Add Certificate

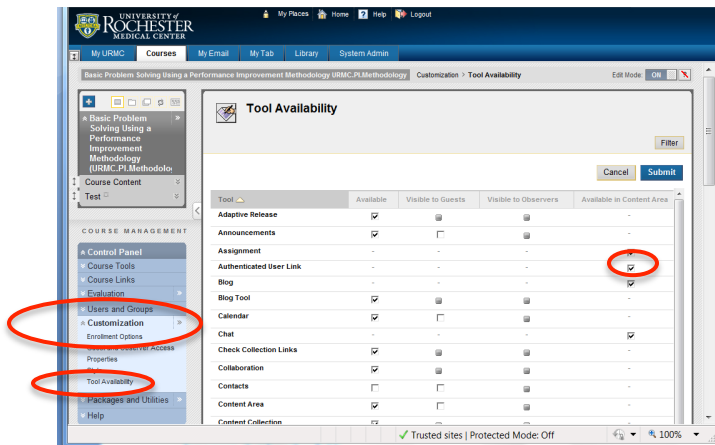
1. In Edit mode, select the “Add Interactive Tool”, button.



2. Click on the “Authenticated User Link”.

If you do not see the “Authenticated User Link” option in the dropdown list, follow these steps to make the tool available within your course.

1. Go to CONTROL PANEL > CUSTOMIZATION> TOOL AVAILABILITY
2. Go to the 4th item down on the list, “Authenticated User Link” and check the box under to AVAILABLE IN CONTENT AREA.
3. Press Submit.



Configure Certificate

1. Authenticated Link Information: Follow the example from the screen shot below. For the URL field, copy and paste in the following:

2. Authentication Information: Be sure to check the following fields
 - First
 - Last
 - Time/Date
 - Custom: Fill in the name of the module or course in the Custom text box
 - a. Options – Configure to **Open in a New Window**
 - b. Submit, test, and add adaptive release rule to certificate

HRMS Bridge Configuration

- a. Once your course development is complete, and before you make your course available, contact “Online Learning” with a written request to have the bridge linked. Include the following information in the request:

- i. Exact name of test or reviewable item to link to.
- ii. Passing score for test (if applicable)

b. The Online Learning team will configure the bridge link. You can double check to make sure that everything is linked by going to Control Panel->Manage HRMS Competency Bridge.

Manage HRMS Competency Bridge

The HRMS Competency Bridge is used to associate, or link, a Blackboard content or gradebook item with an HRMS Competency. Use the buttons in the action bar to define a new link. Once one or more links to competencies have been defined, they will be displayed in the list below the action bar where they may be modified and/or removed. Note that content deployments cannot be modified. If you wish to change a content deployment, you must remove and re-create it.

The "View Attempt Report" button will generate a list of the student progress against items linked to HRMS Competencies in the course. The list is an accurate representation of the data that will be included in the HRMS Competency Bridge report.

c. Click on "View HRMS Competency Attempt Report" to view bridge activity for your course for the past 15 days. If you would like to see historical data, change the number of days to look back.

d. Notice that the bridge processes only currently configured courses, and does not retroactively collect data, so be sure and request bridge configuration before your course becomes available.
