OnCore Two-Step Implementation

Step 1

Protocol and Participant Information

- **Starting now:** This information will be pushed to eRecord by department as soon as all work for that department is finished
- After the push, you can **START** managing participants in OnCore and **STOP** doing it in eRecord

Step 2

Calendars/Financial Information

- **Starting April, 2020:** This information will be pushed to eRecord by department as soon as all work for that department is finished
- Can start visit tracking in OnCore once calendars are released
- After the push, research billing review will be streamlined



Please Prioritize Your Work

- Research Compliance is experiencing an historic volume of work
 - Is prioritizing that work to support Embark and NCI designation
 - 1. Active, billing-risk studies and new oncology studies will be processed first.
 - 2. New, non-oncology studies will be reviewed as Research Compliance is able.
 - Non-billing risk studies (e.g. registry studies, studies with no clinical charges/procedures/billing) will be processed after July 1.
- Please prioritize your work around these guidelines
