Background:

The FLRTC Hazmat for First Receiver Operations Level is OSHA compliant. For details please refer to OSHA Best Practices for Hospital-Based First Receivers, section C.O.

Purpose of Training:

Participants will be provided with the knowledge and materials to execute a Hazmat for the First Receiver Operations Level Course at their own institution.

Prerequisites:

Healthcare personnel current in Hazmat for the First Receiver Operations Level training. This can be accomplished through completion of the Hazmat for the First Receivers Operations Level Provider Course scheduled on the same day or completion of a Hazmat for the First Receiver Operation training within the last 2 months.

OSHA 1910.120(e)(6) Qualifications for trainers: Trainers shall be qualified to instruct employees about subject matter that is being presented in training. Such trainers shall have satisfactorily completed a training program for teaching the subjects they are expected to teach, or they shall have the academic credentials and instructional experience necessary for teaching subjects. Instructors shall demonstrate competent instructional skills and knowledge of the applicable subject matter.

Individuals in the healthcare industry who wish to execute a Hazmat for the First Receiver Operations, Annual Refresher and/or Awareness Level Course at their own institution.
