HAZMAT for the First Receiver Operations Level Provider & Instructor Course

Background:

The FLRTC Hazmat for First Receiver Operations Level is OSHA compliant. For details please refer to <u>OSHA Best Practices for Hospital-Based First</u> Receivers, section C.O.

Purpose of Training:

PROVIDER: Participants will receive information on principles of contamination, the pathophysiology and initial medical management of CBRN agents, decontamination response logistics, and donning and doffing level C PPE appropriately.

INSTRUCTOR: Participants will be provided with the knowledge and materials to execute a Hazmat for the First Receiver Operations Course at their own institution. This one hour session directly follows the Hazmat for First Receiver Operations Level Provider course.

Prerequisites:

PROVIDER: Healthcare personnel who have been or will be assigned to the hospital Hazmat/Decon Team. Must bring facility PAPR to training.

INSTRUCTOR: Healthcare personnel current in Hazmat for the First Receiver Operations Level training. This can be accomplished through completion of the Hazmat for the First Receivers Operations Level Provider Course scheduled on the same day or completion of a Hazmat for the First Receiver Operation training within the last 2 months.

OSHA 1910.120(e)(6) Qualifications for trainers: Trainers shall be qualified to instruct employees about subject matter that is being presented in training. Such trainers shall have satisfactorily completed a training program for teaching the subjects they are expected to teach, or they shall have the academic credentials and instructional experience necessary for teaching subjects. Instructors shall demonstrate competent instructional skills and knowledge of the applicable subject matter.

Target Audience:

PROVIDER: Individuals in the Healthcare industry who may serve as a First Receiver in the hospital facility and may respond to an incident

INSRUCTOR: Individuals in the healthcare industry who wish to execute a Hazmat for the First Receiver Operations, Annual Refresher and/or Awareness Level Course at their own institution.
