Autism Course Work Training

In response to the growing number of children being diagnosed with autism, the NYSED is requiring all persons applying for a teaching certificate or license as a special education teacher or as a school administrator who works in special education, complete a course work or training in the needs of children with autism.

The Community Consultation Program at the Strong Center for Developmental Disabilities/Neurodevelopmental and Behavioral Pediatrics at the Golisano Children's Hospital at Strong, has been approved by NYSED as an Autism Coursework Provider/Trainer and will be offering this course.

The 3-hour training follows the NYSED approved curriculum. After successful completion of the training, participants will be New York State Certified.
