COURSE DESCRIPTION

Neurology is the scientific study of the nervous system, especially in respect to its structure, functions and abnormalities.

The basic function of the nervous system is to trigger and monitor all communication processes in the body. When these processes are not transmitted correctly, neurological problems arise. Neurological problems are frequently seen in a busy internal medicine or family medicine practice.

This full day, case-based program, geared towards family practice physicians, internists, neurologists, pediatricians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners and nurses, will update attendees on gender differences with strokes, peripheral neuropathy, movement disorders and headache.
