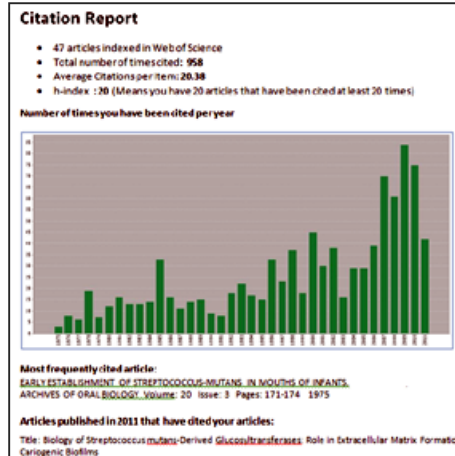

WHO'S CITING YOU?

In the fall, all EIOH faculty received a personal citation report. This document provides detailed information on the number of times an author has been cited, and lists citing articles. The report also includes the author's h-index, a formula that measures the impact of one's work by determining an author's total number of publications and number of citations per publication.

The reports will be offered annually, and as requested.

This year, all first-year residents in AEGD, Pediatric Dentistry, Orthodontics/TMJ, Periodontology and Prosthodontics participated in a library course on Evidence Based Dentistry.

To successfully complete the course, residents were required to complete a CAT. Residents began the assignment by developing a PICO question from a current information need. Next they searched the literature, evaluated their findings, and provided a bottom line statement.
