## Evidence Based Dentistry



New residents and students in GPR, AEGD, Pediatric Dentistry, Prosthodontics and Periodontics completed a course in Evidence Based Dentistry (EBD).

The four-session course, taught by librarian Elizabeth Kettell, covered the theory and practice of EBD. Students learned the five steps of the evidence based process, with an emphasis on developing a clinical question, conducting a literature search, and finding and evaluating evidence based information. Clinical scenarios for practice searches were provided by faculty. The course is offered to new students annually.

Authored by Elizabeth Brayer, this page turner tells the story of philanthropist George Eastman's founding of the Rochester Dental Dispensary. The book depicts the rich history of Eastman Dental, concluding with the establishment of the Eastman Institute for Oral Health in 2009.

# ADA History Book

In celebration of its sesquicentennial, the American Dental Association published “150 Years of the American Dental Association: A Pictorial History, 1959-2009.” The book includes references to former Eastman Dental faculty and images from the Bibby library archive collection. URMC affiliates are welcome to borrow the book.

## Historical Collections

Plans are underway for some of the Bibby Library archives digital collections, together with other local Finger Lakes and Genesee (FLAG) Heritage collections, to be hosted on the statewide research portal NY Heritage ([www.newyorkheritage.org](http://www.newyorkheritage.org)). This will increase the visibility of the collections and help expand the audience for Bibby’s unique images of Rochester’s dental history. The move will occur in Summer 2011, and will be coordinated by the Rochester Regional Library Council.

Currently, the FLAG collections include Bibby library’s images of renowned Eastman dentists such as Dr. Michael Buonocore and Dr. Harvey Burkhart, as well as images from the first days of Eastman Dental, the Tonsil Clinic of 1920, and the founding of Eastman Dental Clinics in Europe. Also included are class pictures from the dispensary’s School for Dental Hygienists, one of the earliest dental hygiene schools in the US. FLAG Heritage currently has 15 member institutions, with roughly 10,000 digital materials contributed.

**1000 Dental Flashcards & Quiz (\$1.99)**  
**3D Head and Neck Skeleton System:** Concentrates on the bones of the head and neck. Allows user to zoom in and identify an individual bone or part of a bone.

**Anatomy of the head and neck (\$2.99)** Quiz

**Anatomy of the Mouth:** (.99) Flash card app to help you learn names, locations and functions of various parts of the mouth.

**Animated Tooth Quiz (\$1.99)** Test your knowledge of human dental anatomy. For testing and educational purposes for people well-informed about the human teeth. Game consists of 48 illustrated questions with the animated images of each separate tooth.

**AO Surgery Reference** (free) includes sections on maxillofacial surgery, midface, mandible, dental alveolar, and skullbase/cranial vault

**Cosmetic Dentistry Calculator (\$3.99):** Analyzes a patient's existing tooth width-to-length ratio; calculates the ideal dimensions of the maxillary anterior teeth based on well-established cosmetic dentistry principles. Starting point for esthetic case planning. A diagnostic tool, it
