

## REVISED ESCROWED FEES POLICY FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

### *International Student Aid Eligibility*

International students are not eligible for financial assistance sponsored or guaranteed by state and federal programs. Therefore, international candidates (REMS and other U of R undergraduate pathways) will be offered *conditional* acceptances to the M.D. program pending verification of their ability to finance their medical education.

### **Verification Requirements:**

#### **CLASS OF 2012 and REMS PROGRAM (for candidates admitted in 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, 2004)**

The policy in existence will be honored for University of Rochester International students admitted to the Class of 2012 and REMS candidates admitted in 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, 2004).

On or before May 15 of the year of matriculation for the M.D. degree, the accepted student must deposit to the School funds sufficient to meet the full expenses of **two** years of enrollment (the full expenses of the first two years of enrollment for students beginning **medical school** in the fall 2008, is \$112,800).

While students will be billed on an annual basis for their remaining years of study at the SMD, with the exception of select Center for Advocacy and Community Health Education and Diversity (CACHED) funded fellowships, financial assistance will **not** be available to international students at **any** time during their matriculation at the School of Medicine.

Matriculated international students will be eligible to apply for CACHED sponsored awards and fellowships that do not require candidates to be US citizens or permanent residents of the US. Consequently, international students are not eligible to receive support from Federal Work Study (FWS), NIH, New York State and other government supported sources.

International students are eligible for the Academic Research Track (ART) approved tuition remission for approved SMD year-out master's degree programs. However, **as a part of the ART year out approval process**, international students will be required to provide evidence of funds to cover their living expenses for the additional year of study.

If an international student's immigration status changes to permanent resident or U.S. citizen in the course of study, **while the pre-paid tuition plan will remain**, he/she can

request termination of the **residual funds** in the holding account, when valid and appropriate documentation of the adjustment is provided to the Bursar's Office.

### **SMD CLASS OF 2013 AND REMS CANDIDATES ADMITTED IN 2009 AND FORWARD**

On or before May 15 of the year of matriculation for the M.D. degree, the accepted student must deposit to the School funds sufficient to meet the full expenses of the four years of enrollment (\*for example fall 2008 entrants must deposit **\$240,000**). \$ 182,000 of this amount will be considered as prepayment of tuition and fees. 25% or up to \$ 14,500 per year will be disbursed to students on the following schedule:

Year I Two \$7, 250 disbursements for a total of \$ 14,500

Year II Two \$7, 250 disbursements for a total of \$ 14,500

Year III Two \$7, 250 disbursements for a total of \$ 14,500

Year IV Two \$7, 250 disbursements (plus any residual funds) for a total of at least \$ 14,500

Matriculated international students will be eligible to apply for CACHED sponsored awards and fellowships that do not require candidates to be US citizens or permanent residents of the US. Consequently, international students are not eligible to receive support from Federal Work Study (FWS), NIH, New York State and other government supported sources.

International students are eligible for the Academic Research Track (ART) approved tuition remission for approved SMD year-out master's degree programs. However, **as a part of the ART year out approval process**, international students will be required to provide evidence of funds to cover their living expenses for the additional year of study.

If an international student's immigration status changes to permanent resident or U.S. citizen in the course of study, **while the pre-paid tuition plan will remain**, he/she can request termination of the **residual funds** in the holding account, when valid and appropriate documentation of the adjustment is provided to the Bursar's Office.

With the exception of select CACHED funded fellowships, financial assistance will not be available to international students at any time during their matriculation at the School of Medicine.
