



Pediatric Video Training For EMS

Purpose and Specific Aims:

The purpose of this project is to continue to build on the successful implementation of a video-based training program for Emergency Medical Services Personnel. The program has already developed more than fifty video segments in thirteen blocks of geriatric and pediatric education. These blocks are available, free of charge, on the Monroe-Livingston Regional EMS Council's website (MLREMS.org).

This grant extends the available pediatric offerings by develop three new blocks of four video segments each in the following topics:

- Block 1—Pediatric Seizures (pathophysiology, diagnosis, treatment)
- Block 2—Pain Control (by age, pharmacological options, distractions, etc)
- Block 3—Live Births/Neonatal Resuscitation in the Field
