Genesee Valley Territory:

To be eligible to register for GVLL program, kids must be between ages 5 and 10 as of **April 30, 2014** and reside within the city's Southwest Quadrant league boundaries which are: *southwest side of the city, south of West Avenue, east along Main St. to downtown south along the river to Genesee Valley Park.*

1st Time Registrants MUST complete a registration form and bring the following:

- ORIGINAL or STATE CERTIFIED copy of child's birth certificate (verified and returned at registration)
 - *If you do not have a copy of your child's birth certificate, GVLL can help you get one.*
- Insurance policy
- Parent or guardian have a current driver license or recognized form of ID.
- *When you volunteer to help you must have either a valid driver license or government issued photo identification. You must also fill out a volunteer application form.*

Returning Players MUST complete a standard registration form in order to participate.
