

Latest Data Show Strong Fertility Center Offers Region's Best IVF Success Rates!

The Society for Assisted Reproductive Technology (SART), the primary organization of professionals dedicated to the practice of assisted reproductive technologies (ART) in the United States, annually collects and publishes IVF success rates from over 390 member clinics. Their most recent report verified that Strong Fertility Center surpasses the national average for IVF in women under 35 years of age.

Over 51% of embryo transfers in women under age 35 resulted in live births. In fact, Strong Fertility Center's IVF success rates are among the nation's best in all age categories, noted by the 38.1% live birth rate per embryo transfer in 38-40 year old women. In addition, Strong Fertility Center has high success rates using frozen embryos and donor eggs, while maintaining the low rates of cancelled cycles, and percentage of live births with triplets or more.

We attribute our success to our renewed focus on patient-centered care, the support and guidance given by our dedicated nurses and staff, and the experience of our embryologists and physicians. Strong Fertility Center's IVF laboratory is directed by Rajesh Srivastava, Ph.D., a skilled embryologist whose arrival in 2006 has correlated with a steady rise in annual success rates.
