Dr. Sala's interests in research are centered on cancer imaging; specifically on advancing the role of imaging utilizing the latest Magnetic Resonance and Spectroscopy Imaging (MRI/MRS) technology as well as PET/CT imaging. Her ongoing research is translational and includes assessing the role of functional MRI (DCE-MRI, DWI, MRS) as a surrogate marker of tumour response to treatment in patients with advanced ovarian and prostate cancer as well as quantification of tumour heterogeneity. Future work will involve correlation of functional MRI and PET/CT parameters with tumour molecular profiling.
