Dr. Reale began the study of the violin at the age of five. His formative years were spent under the tutelage of Ivan Galamian. Thereafter, he worked with artist/teacher Joseph Fuchs. Dr. Reale spent a year between college and medical school at the Juilliard School. Throughout his musical career, he has also pursued the study of chamber music with William Kroll, Lillian Fuchs, Arthur Balsam, Walter Trampler and Edgar Ortenberg. More recently, he has studied with Oleh Krysa and Zvi Zeitlin at the Eastman School of Music. Dr. Reale has performed professionally as a soloist and as a member of chamber music ensembles in Princeton, Boston, Baltimore, New York City and Rochester.



Dr. Toy was born in the San Francisco, Bay Area where he studied piano under the direction of Trula Whelan. He was accepted to the Juilliard School with full scholarship as recipient of the Cliburn Undergraduate Scholarship in piano and the William Petschek prize. He was awarded both a Bachelor and Master's of Music degree from Juilliard as a pupil of Madame Oxana Yablonskaya. He has performed from coast to coast in recital and as a soloist with orchestras in Davies Symphony Hall, the Concord Pavilion, and Alice Tully Hall. He made his Kilbourn Hall debut in a benefit concert for the Wilmot Cancer Center in 2007. He was recently featured on YNN performing a Holiday Concert with Dr. Vincent Reale.
