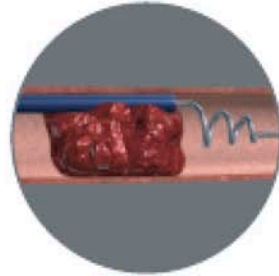
The story was inspired by the show's medical director, a protégée of Sid Starkman, MD at UCLA. The storyline is similar to a case performed during the MERCI Trial.

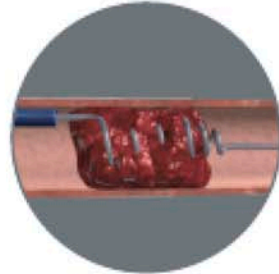
This is a great opportunity to help build awareness of the signs and symptoms of stroke and treatment options. Please encourage everyone you know to watch this episode.

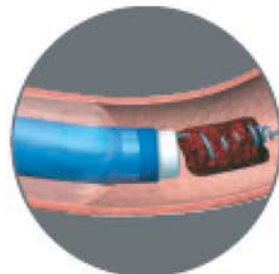
