EASTMAN DEPARTMENT OF DENTISTRY

Eastman Department of Dentistry's mission is to improve oral health through caring, discovery, teaching, and learning. The Department has three components: education, clinical services, and clinical and translational research. With the merger of Eastman Dental Center, the Department has increased its full- and part-time faculty to include over 173 professionals in a number of specialty areas.

RESIDENCY PROGRAMS

The Department offers postdoctoral programs in collaboration with Rochester General and Monroe Community Hospitals in oral and maxillofacial surgery, periodontics, pediatric dentistry, prosthodontics, orthodontics and dentofacial orthopaedics, and general dentistry. A fellowship in temporomandibular joint disorders is also available.

The Department offers several combined areas of study including a combined oral and maxillofacial surgery training/M.D. program. Postdoctoral residents can combine their residency training with an M.S. offered by the Center for Oral Biology or the M.P.H. in clinical investigation offered by the Department of Community and Preventive Medicine.

RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES

The training grants offered by the Eastman Department of Dentistry include the Rochester Short-Term Training for Oral Health Clinical Trials. This grant is directed at developing outstanding clinical researchers conversant with the design, budgeting, implementation, data management, and statistical methodology of controlled dental, oral, and craniofacial clinical trials. A training grant in periodontics is also available.

In addition, the residents in the Department's postdoctoral programs can apply to the Dental Scientist Program, administered by the Center for Oral Biology. This program is designed to develop individuals who have a dental degree into highly competent dental scientists. Training in a specialty area or general dentistry is combined with coursework and research in a basic science area.

Most candidates in the graduate degree programs are accepted as graduate students and hold dual appointments. Those pursuing Ph.D. degree programs are members of one of the basic science departments. For course information, see the Center for Oral Biology.

DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MEDICINE

The Department of Emergency Medicine was created in 1992. Our new, state-of-the-art Emergency Department facility opened in early 2001. The Department is committed to clinical, academic, and teaching excellence in emergency care. The goal of the Department is to provide expert care to all of its patients and to serve as a regional referral center in the areas of trauma, medical emergencies, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, epilepsy, pediatrics, and emergency orthopaedics, as well as providing rapid care for less acute problems.

The Department is a major teaching area for medical students, nursing students, house officers, emergency medical technicians, and paramedics, and is the home of the Emergency Medicine Residency and Pediatric Emergency Medicine Fellowship programs. The Department takes pride in being innovative in providing outstanding clinical care to patients while attempting to objectively measure the quality of the care it provides. Another of the Department's goals is to foster close ties with the emergency medical services community and to provide leadership, guidance, and quality of care reviews for in-the-field practice.

We in emergency medicine believe expert patient care, innovative teaching, and original clinical research can all occur simultaneously. The Department has over 30 faculty members, nearly all of whom are board certified in emergency medicine and/or pediatric emergency medicine.
