## **DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY MEDICINE**

The Department of Family Medicine was originally established in 1967 as a residency program located at Highland Hospital, one of the University's affiliated hospitals. In 1979, the family medicine program became a division within the Department of Preventive, Family, and Rehabilitation Medicine, and in 1987, a separate department of the medical school, based primarily at Highland Hospital. Members of the Department contribute to a number of courses in the medical school curriculum. The Department's accredited residency program is one of the oldest and most respected in the country. Faculty research efforts are focused on family systems, reproductive health, and health services delivery.

### **COURSES AND CLERKSHIPS**

The Department of Family Medicine participates fully in clinical and classroom-based education throughout all four years of the medical school curriculum. Family Medicine clinical sites reflect a commitment to training students in the care of the underserved in rural and inner-city areas. Classroom teaching programs emphasize a multidisciplinary, biopsychosocial approach to care.

Family Medicine preceptors and faculty form the backbone of the clinical strand in the first two years of the Double Helix Curriculum: Introduction to Clinical Medicine and the Ambulatory Clerkship. The Department provides a large portion of the clinical placements, and provides seminars and conferences on management of chronic disease, prevention, physical examination skills, evidence-based care, home care, palliative care, mental health, family dynamics, and communication skills.

The Department offers a four-week, third-year clinical clerkship, based in outpatient community settings, and includes a seminar series, direct observation of clinical skills with feedback, home visits, and student-directed seminar sessions. The Department offers a rural Family Medicine Externship as one option in completing the fourth-year externship requirement; it includes inpatient and outpatient experience based at regional hospitals and affiliated family physicians' practices.

Dr. Ronald Epstein, Director of Predoctoral Education in the Department, is responsible for the Comprehensive Assessment at the end of the second and third years of the Double Helix Curriculum. The Comprehensive Assessment is designed to evaluate students' ability to function as generalist physicians by the end of the four years of medical school, and help students design remediation plans to accomplish educational objectives.

The Department of Family Medicine offers elective summer research opportunities and elective preceptorships in rural practices throughout New York State.

## RESIDENCY PROGRAM IN FAMILY MEDICINE

This fully accredited three-year program is based at Highland Hospital, with the family practice unit located across the street in the Jacob W. Holler Family Medicine Center. The program's goal is to train community-oriented family physicians in the biopsychosocial approach to health care. The distinguishing features of this program are resident pairing, strong OB training, urban and underserved population, and fully integrated family systems medicine. The program values and supports educational flexibility, personal and professional balance, and intellectual rigor.

## DIVISION OF GENETICS

The Division of Genetics is an interdepartmental division. Its present members have appointments in the Departments of Medicine, Pediatrics, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Neurology, Oncology, Pathology and Laboratory Medicine, and Microbiology and Immunology.

Division members engage in a variety of research, educational, and service activities. Their research deals with the genetics of higher organisms, man in particular, with special emphasis on human genetic disease. Research training is offered to medical students, to graduate students, and to individuals holding an M.D. or Ph.D. degree.

Faculty of the Division offer a variety of genetic patient services, including diagnostic consultation and genetic counseling; they also offer a variety of genetic laboratory services and are concerned with the development of improved diagnostic methods. Opportunities for training in medical genetics is offered to medical students and to the residency staff. Research is also conducted on the evaluation of genetic services.
