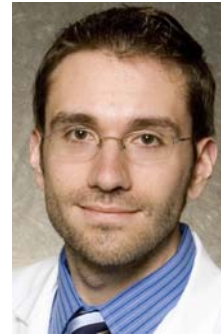
Bradley Schwartz, MD
