Essentially, since it is a collection of songs, we have the flexibility to rehearse numbers individually and will be scheduled based on the participants' availability. 1) Please sign up for a 5-minute audition slot by clicking on a "grey box" which corresponds to particular time and fill in **your a) name, b) email address, c) phone number**. If you have difficulties signing up (a google account may be required, **If you are having difficulties signing up, please email me a half hour interval when you are free and I will assign you a 5 min time slot myself**).

2) Please sign up for one and only one time slot. (only one person per time slot please)

3) Please do your best to arrive 10-15min before your scheduled time so that you have time to take off your coat, go over your music, complete our audition form and prepare so that you are ready when we call you into audition. We will do our best to stay on schedule and run the auditions as efficiently as possible, and ask for everyone's help in advance by arriving promptly.

4) **Please sign up early**. Preference is determined on a first come, first served basis and early sign ups will make everything logistically easier.

What should I prepare for auditions?

For the auditions, please prepare a song that best shows off your voice. Ideally, this would be from a Broadway/musical theatre song, but if you've never auditioned before and feel that you sing "Happy Birthday" really well, please feel free to sing that. I probably won't have you sing through the whole song, but please be prepared to do so just in case.

1) **PLEASE BRING SHEET MUSIC (unless you do not have any available)**

- 2) An accompanist (piano player) will be provided.
- 3) You are also welcome to bring theatre resumes and headshots, but **these are not required**.

It is my goal to get everyone interested involved in the production in some capacity. With large community collaborative projects like this, I find the most rewarding part to be the relationships that form within the cast and the memories that we make together. I want everyone to enjoy themselves and feel a part of this memorable project.

What about dress code? Please wear whatever you feel comfortable in.

What if I can't attend auditions/the only time slots I could audition in are already filled?

Please let me know if you are unable to attend auditions and we'll find a way to work something out. If you are in town, please find a 5 min slot to come and audition. One of the greatest challenges is coordinating a time that works well for everyone. Flexibility is much appreciated, but if there is an unavoidable conflict, we'll figure something out.

Directions to Medical Student Lounge (Red Star on the Attached Map)

(ground floor of the School of Medicine and Dentistry)

- 1) Enter School of Medicine and Dentistry Through Glass Doors
- 2) After entering the building, proceed directly forward through a second set of glass door, continue down the corridor.
- 3) Pass through a third set of doors and make an immediate right turn (you'll have to turn right or left).
- 4) Proceed down this hallway to the end.
- 5) You will see a big glass wall in front of you. This is the medical student lounge.

We will have people stationed throughout to help lead you to the room should you get lost.
