Dr. Hoyo is a former clinical director of post doctoral endodontics at Boston University. He maintains a private practice limited to endodontics in Rochester. Dr. Hoyo has lectured extensively demonstrating the vertical compaction technique in the United States, Brazil and Germany.

Dr. Fayad is assistant clinical professor of endodontics at the University of Illinois and also maintains a private practice limited to endodontics in Chicago. He has lectured nationally and internationally on "Microendodontics" (use of microscope in dentistry).
