As a part of the Department of Psychiatry, the Office of Mental Health Promotion (OMHP) aims to provide a space for local artists to display their artwork while at the same time creating a lovely and therapeutic environment for the patients, families and employees of Strong Behavioral Health.

High school artists are asked to create work that reflects the show's title, "Through My Eyes".

Only 2D, less than 1 inch thick mediums will be considered, including works on paper, *un-stretched* canvas, and masonite. Frames are provided and locked. There are 2 frame sizes 18x20" and 20x24" with preset orientations. If chosen, we will give you direction on your artwork's orientation and matting size.

Submit up to three images of artwork. The art will be juried for Best in Show and Top Juror's Picks by the Department of Psychiatry and a select community artist. Feel free to come and preview our gallery or call with questions before submitting. Visit our website for more details
