

## **Candidate Selection Criteria**

The Cancer Control Research Training Program seeks individuals with recent doctorates (Ph.D., Dr.P.H., M.D.) in health related areas, as well as more experienced individuals with similar degrees wishing to change their research focus and who are highly motivated to develop a successful research career in cancer control.

Candidates must be United States citizens or permanent residents. Two years of funding with a stipend of \$60,000 offered along with tuition, health insurance, research support, travel allowances and an appointment as a Research Assistant Professor in the School of Medicine. Applications from women and minorities are strongly encouraged. The position will begin during the Summer of 2020.

## **How to Apply**

Applicants submit:

1. A curriculum vitae
2. A statement of your interest telling specifically how this program would help you get from where you are to where you want to be professionally (a convincing section on your passion for research is a definite plus)
3. Three signed academic letters of support (have them sent to you and include them with the other two required items when you submit the completed application)

The application deadline is **February 1, 2020**. Applications may be emailed or mailed.
