



Candidate Selection Criteria

The Cancer Control Research Training Program seeks individuals with recent doctorates (Ph.D., Dr.P.H., M.D.) in health related areas, as well as more experienced individuals with similar degrees wishing to change their research focus and who are highly motivated to develop a successful research career in cancer control.

Candidates must be United States citizens or permanent residents. Two years of funding with a stipend of \$60,000 offered along with tuition, health insurance, research support, travel allowances and an appointment as a Research Assistant Professor in the School of Medicine. Applications from women and minorities are strongly encouraged.
