Simulation-based training and other experiential learning modalities are fast becoming the gold standard in health professions education. Using simulation-including standardized patients, simple task trainers, computer-enhanced patient mannequins, procedural trainers, and virtual reality-physicians, nurses, and other healthcare providers can master basic manipulative skills, complex cognitive and interdisciplinary teamwork skills and challenging technical procedures without risk to patients.
