[Maternal Labor Epidural Analgesia May Be Linked to Autism in Children](#)

A study published in JAMA Network Open found that the risk of autism spectrum disorder in children was increased with exposure to maternal labor epidural analgesia, independent of exposure to oxytocin, while there was no significant association between the risk of ASD and exposure to oxytocin. Findings, based on 205,994 singleton births with vaginal deliveries, also showed that 2.5% of children had a diagnosis of ASD.

[Oral glibenclamide studied for gestational diabetes](#)

Oral glibenclamide had a similar effect on fasting blood glucose and two-hour postprandial glucose, as well as rate of preeclampsia, hypoglycemia and preterm labor, as subcutaneous insulin, among women with gestational diabetes. The findings in Obstetric Medicine indicate that "oral glibenclamide is as safe and effective as subcutaneous insulin in glycemic control and maternal and neonatal outcomes in women with gestational diabetes," the researchers wrote.

[Neurodevelopmental Delay Seen in Offspring of Moms With Low Fiber Intake](#)

A study published in Frontiers in Nutrition found that children of mothers who had low fiber intake during pregnancy were more likely to show neurodevelopmental delays, including a higher risk of delays in communication, fine motor, problem-solving and personal-social skills. Findings were based on 76,207 mother-infant pairs in which maternal dietary fiber intake was estimated using the food frequency questionnaire in mid-pregnancy.
