Editorial Board

The goal of the periFACTS OB/GYN Academy's Editorial Board is to develop and maintain good working relationships between the Editorial Board, potential writers, and the office staff.

Editor-in-Chief

The role of the Editor-in-Chief sets the tone of office, while moving the program forward into new areas of education.

The Editor-in-Chief's typical duties include:

- Working with the Program Development staff and writers to select obstetric and gynecologic topics for the upcoming year.
- Contacting writers to gain their commitment to write articles for the periFACTS OB/GYN Academy and ensure that they submit their articles by the assigned deadline.
- Editing the first read of every article, and the last read to assure that the editing process has been completed.
- Running interference between the office staff and outside writers.
- Resolving issues of clarity and accuracy with the writers as they pertain to their articles.
- Producing a monthly educational video.
- Writing a monthly Pause for menopause article.
- Chairing weekly editorial meetings where clinical case studies and review tests are reviewed for clarity and accuracy.

Medical Associate Editors

The Editor-in-Chief delegates work to the Medical Associate Editors that includes, but is not limited to, editing all of the articles and educational materials published by the periFACTS OB/GYN Academy (educational materials include clinical case studies, educational videos, supplementary materials, and textbooks); writing articles for the periFACTS OB/GYN Academy; and performing other duties the Editor-in-Chief deems necessary.

Clinical Associate Editors
