The American College of Radiology and Society of Breast Imaging recommend that women begin receiving annual mammograms at age 40, with added vigilance for those in historically overlooked populations. Both shared updated guidance in the Journal of the American College of Radiology on June 18. Their recommendations are based on an "extensive" data from randomized controlled trials and peer-reviewed literature.
