[5 to 7 Hours of Sleep Per Day Lowers Mortality Risk in Patients with Type 2 Diabetes](#)

A study published in the journal *Cardiovascular Diabetology* found that patients with type 2 diabetes who slept for five to seven hours per day had the lowest risk for all-cause and expanded cardiovascular disease mortality. Meanwhile, those who slept for less or more than seven hours per night, those age 65 and older, those who used insulin and those who had been diagnosed with diabetes by age 45 had greater mortality risk.

Non-Hispanic Black women with advanced maternal age had the lowest odds of developing gestational diabetes, yet neonates of Black women with gestational diabetes at any age had the highest odds of being admitted to the NICU.
