

Process for Handling Cases Requiring Corrections, Retractions, and Editorial Expressions of Concern

Honest errors in post-publication materials, although carefully screened for, are unavoidable. When an error is found, an immediate correction or retraction must be published. An immediate correction includes an announcement by the Editor-in-Chief to the Journal's participants and an immediate replacement of the affected article. All versions of the article, pre- and post-publication are archived electronically and are available to participants at their request.

If a participant raises a concern about the article after the article is published, the Editor-in-Chief, Medical Associate Editors, and Clinical Associate Editors will evaluate that concern. If the concern is found to be a compelling concern, the Editor-in-Chief will communicate the correction to the participants by posting a letter on the periFACTS OB/GYN Adademy's website.
