

## Faculty credit for learning associated with preparing and presenting an original presentation

## The AMA Physician's Recognition Award and credit system (2017 revision) states:

Accredited CME providers may also award AMA PRA Category 1 Credit<sup>TM</sup> to their physician faculty to recognize the learning associated with the preparation and teaching of an original presentation at the accredited CME provider's live activities that are certified for AMA PRA Category 1 Credit<sup>TM</sup>.

Credit for faculty is calculated on a 2-to-1 ratio to presentation time, rounded to the nearest quarter credit.

- Credit may only be claimed once for an original presentation; credit may not be claimed for subsequent presentations of the same material.
- Physician faculty may not claim credit as a participant for their own presentations, but may claim credit for other segments they attend as a participant.

To receive CME credit for the learning associated with preparing and presenting an original presentation, the speaker should complete the following information:
