

Do you have an autism spectrum disorder?

Would you like to learn more about managing your health care and medications?

Researchers at the University of Rochester are conducting a study to test an intervention for youth and young adults with autism spectrum disorder. Participants will receive instruction on navigating health care and managing medication. They will either attend classroom sessions or complete a self-study course.

The study is supported by the National Institutes of Health and is being done in collaboration with investigators at the American Academy of Pediatrics.



Who is eligible to participate in this research project?
