

2015-2016 Federal Poverty Guidelines 250% Guidelines

To determine if you are under the 250% Federal Poverty Guidelines match your household size to your monthly/annual income*.

For example: If your household size is 4, the total monthly/annual income* should be approximately \$5,052.

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Monthly</u>	<u>/</u>	<u>Annual</u>
1	\$2,452	/	\$29,425
2	\$3,319	/	\$39,825
3	\$4,185	/	\$50,225
4	\$5,052	/	\$60,625
5	\$5,919	/	\$71,025
6	\$6,785	/	\$81,425
7	\$7,652	/	\$91,825
8	\$8,519	/	\$102,225

For each additional person who lives in your household above 8, add \$347.00 monthly or \$4,160 annually.

****Monthly/Annual Household Income is the sum of income (salary, child support, unemployment, etc) received by ALL members of your household including members not related to you.***
