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Monica Sharma, trained as a physician and epidemiologist, worked for the United Nations since 1988 for 22 years. Most recently, she is the author “Radical Transformational Leadership” a book that describes how we can source our inner capacities and wisdom to manifest change, citing examples from different parts of the world. It describes how we can embody universal values of dignity, compassion and fairness, and simultaneously transform unworkable systems and norms in order to solve problems. Winner of the 2017 Nautilus Gold Book Award for Business and Leadership, this book deconstructs fallacies that societies continue to promote, related to self and the world around us that leads to complacency and non-action.
