Prolonged Service Codes

Prolonged Service Description

Prolonged Service codes 99417 and 99418, are used when a physician or other qualified health care professional provides prolonged service involving direct (face-to-face) patient contact or without direct (non-face-to-face) patient contact that is beyond the highest level of service in either the inpatient or outpatient setting.

Documentation

 Document and identify total time with or without direct patient contact beyond the usual service, on the date of the primary service or the non-face-to-face services that occur on a different date than the face-to-face visit.

Example: "I personally spent ____ minutes on the calendar day of the encounter, including pre and post visit work."

- The medical record must be appropriately and sufficiently documented by the physician or qualified health care professional to show that they personally provided the direct face-toface time with the patient.
- Documentation must support or easily infer how the time was spent. Include descriptions to support the extended service time.

Documentation Examples:

- "I spoke to cardiology ..."
- "I received the past medical chart the patient brought with him from Florida."
- "I spoke to the patients Social Worker at the group home about the need for a higher level of care ..."
- "I spoke at length today with Ms. Jones and her family about the prognosis and treatment options. I contacted the Finger Lakes infusion center to make sure they could schedule her on Fridays only."

Time: Personal time spent on the calendar date of the encounter activities include:

- Preparing to see the patient (e.g., review of tests)
- Obtaining and/or reviewing separately obtained history
- Performing a medically appropriate examination and/or evaluation
- Counseling and educating the patient/family/caregiver
- Ordering medications, tests, or procedures

- Referring and communicating with other health care professionals (when not separately reported)
- Documenting clinical information in the electronic or other health record
- Documenting clinical information in the electronic or other health record
- Care coordination (not separately reported)

<u>Threshold Times for Code 99417 beyond the usual service:</u> For prolonged E&M services on the date of an outpatient service, home or residence service, or cognitive assessment and care plan, use 99417.

<u>Threshold Times for Code 99418 beyond the usual service:</u> For Inpatient/Observation or nursing facility E&M prolonged services on the date, use 99418 is only used when the primary service highest-level has been exceeded by 15 minutes.

This table helps avoid any confusion over code choice for Medicare and private payer patients, and to calculate at which point the service will require a prolonged E&M services add-on code.
