

Mandatory Prescriber Education

Prescribers licensed under Title Eight of the Education Law in New York to treat humans and who have a DEA registration number to prescribe controlled substances, must take at least three (3) hours of course work or training in pain management, palliative care, and addiction. After completing the training, they are required to attest that the training is complete.

Organizations like the NYS DOH or Joint Commission may audit our medical staff's status at any time. To keep track of the URMC medical staff meeting this requirement, Medical Staff Services (MSS) is collecting the confirmation of completion of both the training and the attestation.

1. Prescriber completes education requirement & sends confirmation of completion to MSS.

The three (3) hours of course work or training can be completed through any of the following pre-approved courses:

• New York American College of Physicians (NYACP) *\$20 fee for third module
