

Immediate Tooth Replacement Therapy with Multiple Implants, Teeth and Pontics in the Esthetic Zone

Current trends in implant therapy advocate clinical techniques, thereby allowing treatment efficiency consisting of condensed clinical procedures, fewer patient appointments and shortened overall treatment time. Even though there is overwhelming literature to support positive outcomes in regard to implant survival through immediate implant therapy and tooth replacement strategies, esthetics questions still loom, specifically how to handle multiple tooth sites in the esthetic zone.

This presentation will address treatment planning strategies with multiple tooth sites incorporating teeth, immediate implants with tooth replacement and pontics in the esthetic zone, as well as innovative devices and strategies in provisional restoration fabrication.

Dr. Chu maintains an academic appointment as Adjunct Clinical Professor in the Ashman Department of Periodontology and Implant Dentistry and the Department of Prosthodontics at New York University College of Dentistry.
