



HOW DOES TELEDENTISTRY WORK?

Teledentistry connects patients, caregivers, and providers by using a special, high-definition, intraoral camera.


A staff member or nurse from your facility will be trained to operate an intraoral camera to look in the client's mouth and take pictures and videos.

The process allows:

- Staff to coordinate a virtual appointment with an Eastman Dental provider to review the patient's oral concerns
- Group home staff to send photos taken with the camera to a dentist, who will review the pictures to see if additional follow-up care is needed
- Dentists at Eastman Dental to assess the status of previously existing dental condition
- Clients and staff to be spared from stressful and unnecessary travel when treatment can be postponed
- Family members and caregivers to participate in the client's visit with the dentist

How can teledentistry help your clients?

Unfortunately, current safety restrictions are leading to increased oral health problems among group home residents. But teledentistry makes it possible to maintain safety while providing dental examinations to patients right where they live. When caught early, oral disease can be reversed or managed with appropriate oral hygiene, fluoride exposure, dental sealants, changes in diet, and other measures.



What are the benefits of teledentistry?

- Convenience! The virtual appointment is provided on-site at your facility, so staff and clients don't need to travel for dental appointments unless required for follow-up care or emergencies.
- Improved access to dental care for clients with limited mobility.
- Reduced risk of exposure to germs, COVID-19, flu, and/or airborne illnesses.
- Improved quality of life by reducing pain and preventing disease.

- Early or untreated cavities/tooth decay
