

GME Residency Programs

1. Must have a DDS or DMD degree.
2. NYS license or limited permit – must register yearly and meet educational requirements. **NOTE:** for graduates of foreign dental schools to be eligible for a GME stipend position you must meet specific requirements for licensure as contained in Title 8, [Article 133](#), Section 6604 of New York State Education Law and [Part 61](#) of the Commissioner's Regulations.
3. Citizenship/Immigration Status – If other than a US citizen or permanent resident, we only sponsor F1 visas for dental residency positions. If visa sponsorship is required applicant will be instructed, upon acceptance, to complete a SEVIS New Admissions Data form. This will begin the process with the UR International Service Office for applying for the F1 visa status.
4. National Board Exam scores – sent directly from the ADA Joint Commission of National Dental Examinations.
5. Three (3) letters of recommendation – one (1) letter from dental school dean and two (2) letters from senior faculty members or other appropriate people.
6. Picture ID.
