

Interdisciplinary treatment in the digital era

Interdisciplinary treatment can be a necessary or important adjunct to prosthodontic therapy especially for patients with severely mutilated dentitions or those with less complex conditions, but with high esthetic demands.

The introduction and continuous development of digital technologies and workflows has certainly enhanced the possibility for interdisciplinary patient management, but also added potential more sources of complexity for the clinicians. From diagnosis to therapy, including imaging, dental impressions, implant surgery, orthodontic therapies, and prostheses material and manufacturing, digital workflows and technologies have transformed the way each specialty of dentistry can be practiced.

Unfortunately, treatment management involving different clinicians may be frustrating and ineffective interaction between different specialties may lead to additional problems instead of solutions, result in enormous waste of time and money and ultimately achieve far from ideal results. The clinicians, therefore, must have a good working knowledge of how to effectively optimize interactions and workflows between different disciplines in order to develop a patient-centered comprehensive treatment plan. Optimal multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary management should maximize treatment

results by synergizing the knowledge, skills and treatment modalities of the different dental disciplines while minimizing frustrations and shortcomings that may inevitably occur in treatment management. Digital tools offer a great chance to achieve these objectives.

Therefore, this lecture will explore the current and future needs for interdisciplinary treatments and explore how most recent digital technologies can be applied to meet our patients' needs and desires. Clinical examples and interdisciplinary scenarios will be used to describe what and why is important in interdisciplinary treatments, how digital technologies are changing the ways we treat patients and what has actually not changed at all!
