Residents will work under the supervision of our Residency Program Director, Jim Tacci in his role as head of Occupational Health at Xerox Corporation. Activities will include a mix of assisting with acute care visits by employees, planning wellness programs and delivering them, and investigating laws and policies related to ensuring employee health and safety as issues arise.

Concentra

Concentra is a national provider of occupational medicine services and emergent care facilities. Residents will see a mix of workers compensation and emergent care patients at the Lee Road facility, located about 5 miles away from the medical center on the industrial northwest side of Rochester, under the supervision of Dr. George Anstadt, former President of the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine (ACOEM). Physical and occupational therapy is also offered at this site, so residents have the option of working with the therapists as well. This experience can be done as a block practicum of 3-4 months or it may be done as a weekly or bi-weekly clinical practice experience of no less than eight, 1/2 days.

U of Rochester Department of (Environmental) and Occupational Medicine

Residents can pursue one of two options for their rotation in the Department of Environmental and Occupational medicine.

- They may pursue a research project or community outreach project related to environmental health. This option would require advanced planning by the resident in that the project would need to be set up before starting this rotation.
- The second option is a clinical rotation at the offsite Occupational Medicine Clinic in one of Rochester's suburbs.
 - Residents will participate in clinical care and observe how occupational medicine is practiced in an academic medical setting as opposed to Concentra which is a private practice/community setting. .
 - Residents will also have the opportunity in developing and carrying out corporate wellness plans.
 - This clinical experience can be done as a block practicum of 3-4 months or it may be done as a weekly or bi-weekly clinical practice experience of no less than eight, 1/2 days.
 - Physical and occupational therapy is also offered at this site, so residents have the option of working with the therapists as well.
