Dr. Jennifer Hunter is an Associate Professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Rochester. She holds secondary appointments with the Center for Visual Science, The Institute of Optics, and Biomedical Engineering. She received her PhD in Physics and Vision Science (2007) from the University of Waterloo. Dr. Hunter's research interests include development of non-invasive fluorescence imaging techniques to study retinal function in healthy and diseased eyes and mechanisms of light-induced retinal damage. She serves on the editorial board of the Journal of the Optical Society of America A, represents the Visual Psychophysics/Physiological Optics (VI) section on the ARVO Annual Meeting Program Committee, and is an active member of the ANSI Z136 Safe Use of Lasers standards committees. Dr. Hunter was a 2017 recipient of a Research to Prevent Blindness Ernest & Elizabeth Althouse Special Scholar Award and a member of the 2020 class of OSA Fellows.
