



**CALL FOR APPLICANTS FOR JULY 2023: University of Rochester Primary Care
Research Fellowship Program
Deadline: January 15, 2023**

We are accepting applications for a July 2023 start date for a 2-year postdoctoral research fellowship for MD/DOs, PhDs, PsyDs and others holding doctoral degrees in health professions. The program is funded by a National Research Service Award (NRSA) grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).

Our **faculty** focus their scholarship on clinical and health services research related to vulnerable children and adults, and mentor and work closely with fellows.



The purpose of this program is to train and provide support to postdoctoral health care professionals who are planning to pursue careers in biomedical and behavioral health research related to primary care, with a focus on reducing health disparities.

Fellows are trained in the **key domains of research, population health, and leadership/career development, with a focus on health disparities**. Weekly seminars offer instruction on research, health disparities, leadership, education, career development and scientific writing. Fellows regularly present developing ideas and project results. As fellows complete mentored projects, they present at national meetings and publish in peer-reviewed journals. Many MD fellows pursue advanced degrees, including a [MPH](#), [Master of Science in Clinical Investigation](#) or [Master of Science in Health Services and Policy](#). PhD fellows may choose from a wealth of related coursework.

Applicants must be U.S. Citizens. Fellows may hold either MD/DO, DNP, DDS, PsyD or PhD degrees. Grant funded stipends require a 75% commitment to research. We strongly encourage applications from individuals from underrepresented groups in health services research.
