PATHWAYS OVERVIEW



- Pathway programs provide medical students with an enriched experience in one of six areas of interest over all 4 years of medical school
- Students have diversified opportunities in a variety of clinical and research activities, courses and electives, as well as special events and competitive awards.
- Admission to the Pathway is through a competitive application process and is limited to 10 students each year in most Pathways.
