Congratulations!

Nicole Acquisto will be recognized in October as a Fellow of the American College of Clinical Pharmacy (ACCP). This is a very significant professional achievement that is extended to just 20-30 pharmacists per year worldwide. Nicole had to be nominated by an existing Fellow of ACCP, had to submit a detailed portfolio of her accomplishments and contributions to practice, research or teaching in the area of clinical pharmacy as well as her contributions to ACCP. The FCCP committee recommended Nicole as a Fellow to the ACCP Board of Regents to approve. It typically requires at least 10-15 years of sustained and meaningful contributions to the profession and the organization to achieve FCCP status....so this is no small achievement!

Courtney Jones was nominated by a group of graduate students and selected as the 2017 recipient of the Outstanding Graduate Student Teacher Award. Established in 2013, this award is based on an instructor's record of excellence in classroom instruction, as reflected by the letter of nomination from students enrolled in one or more courses in which the teacher has delivered a significant number of lectures and by course-instructor survey evaluations. The award comes with \$2,500 for education related expenses. The award will be presented at the School of Medicine and Dentistry Convocation Ceremony on Tuesday, September 12th at 4:00pm in the Class of 1962 Auditorium.
