**ENHANCING THE TRANSLATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH RESEARCH  
INTO APPLICATIONS TO IMPROVE HUMAN HEALTH**

The Integrative Health Sciences Facility (IHSFC), of the Environmental Health Sciences Center (EHSC), has funds to support a limited number of Translational Pilot Projects. The objective of the pilot project should be relevant to the mission of the IHSFC, namely **to enhance the translation of environmental health research into applications to improve human health.**

- *Applications are limited to EHSC Faculty members (non center members are encouraged to apply but **must** collaborate with EHSC Faculty)*
- *Projects should generate critical preliminary data for future grant applications*
- *Funds are limited to research expenses, and cannot be used to support travel, faculty salary or equipment purchases*
- *Project budgets should generally not exceed \$8000*

- Name and contact information for Principal Investigator and co-Investigator(s)
- A description of the goals and objectives of your proposed project
- Relevance of the project to the mission of the IHSFC
- Indication of how the proposed studies will facilitate future grant submissions
- “Other Support” indicating lack of overlap with currently funded projects
- Total budget requested

**Applications are accepted April 1, August 1 and December 1**
