

Family planning clinics, providers, and pharmacies may accept many different insurances as payment for services and birth control methods. The programs listed provide comprehensive, confidential family planning and reproductive health care services to all women, men and adolescents regardless of ability to pay or immigration status. If a client does not have insurance coverage, a sliding fee scale based on the client's income is used to determine if a fee will be charged.

NYS FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAMS

In addition, NYS Medicaid offers qualified residents programs designed to help people access family planning services. Nearly all family planning clinics enroll patients into these programs at their clinic locations!

Family Planning Benefit Program: Provides coverage for family planning services to men and women with gross incomes at or below 223% of the federal poverty level. This includes teens!

Family Planning Extension Program: Women who lose Medicaid coverage when a pregnancy ends receive free family planning services for up to two years!

What is family planning?

Family planning is more than planning families! Confidential care is available for women, men and teens.

Family planning services include:

- Birth control options including abstinence
- Well women screening including PAP tests and breast exams
- Pregnancy tests and pregnancy options counseling
- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
- HIV counseling and testing
- Emergency contraception

For more information on these services, talk to your health care provider.
