Description:

This session will provide participants with a sound understanding of Continuity of Operations Planning, or COOP. The session will include the steps and concepts in the COOP process, identifying and planning for continuance of mission essential functions, and provide participants with solutions to addressing COOP on an agency-specific platform, or jurisdiction-wide platform. Participants will be exposed to a variety of COOP methodologies, incorporating the best core concepts of both the public and private sector.

Course Curriculum and Topics:

State planning guidance on COOP/BCP, Federal planning guidance, NFPA 1600, multiple private sector standards (BS-25777, NIST, FFIEC).

Prerequisites:

Participants must have completed the FEMA Independent Study (IS) courses: 546a, Continuity of Operations Awareness Course; and 547a, Introduction to Continuity of Operations Course to enhance the learning experience. Both are available here:
